



## **The London Accident Prevention Council pays tribute to Chris King, winner of 'Laurie Bunn Road Safety Award 2008'**



Chris King scooped the prestigious Laurie Bunn Road Safety Award during the London Accident Prevention Council's 91<sup>st</sup> Annual event on July 23<sup>rd</sup> held in the St Bride Foundation, London.
